

PLANNING POLICY STATEMENTS

- This Plan serves as a guide to future detailed structure planning and rezoning amendments.
- Urban development is to occur in accordance with the Strategy Plan. No urban development shall occur to the west of South Western Highway.
- Subdivision and development within the identified expansion area is not to occur until such time as the land is appropriately zoned in both the Greater Busselton Region Scheme and the Local Planning Scheme and a detailed Structure Plan has been adopted by the Shire and the WARC.
- Structure Plans and Scheme Amendments may apply to either the whole expansion area or parts thereof.
- Subdivision of land will only be supported where consistent with the staging requirements of this Strategy.
- The vision for Burekup generally is to achieve an attractive, walk friendly and sustainable village within a rural setting, with a population of up to 1,200 persons. All structure Plans are to demonstrate consistency with this vision.
- Structure Plans are to be prepared in accordance with the provisions of the Local Planning Scheme No. 2 applicable to the Development Zone and Lateral Neighbourhood design policy.
- If a Structure Plan is submitted for a portion of the identified expansion area only, it is to be accompanied by a Control Plan for the balance of the expansion area which identifies how the proposed will link with, and be complementary to, the future planning of surrounding and adjoining Structure Plan areas.
- As a minimum, the areas of public open space as shown on the Strategy Plan are to be identified for public open space purposes on any Structure Plan and offered to the Crown as a condition of subdivision. The vesting and long term management of POCs areas is to be resolved at the Structure Plan stage.
- Structure Plan(s) are to identify vegetated buffers at the interface of residential expansion and the surrounding rural area which are to be inclusive of roads and native vegetation. If necessary, Structure Plans are to identify suitable minimums for mitigating noise from major road or rail infrastructure.
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- A Community Needs Analysis which is to determine the requirement for any necessary community facilities and infrastructure and the subdivisions responsibility for their provision, including monetary contributions consistent with draft Stage 3.
- A File Management Plan (FMP) is to be accompanied by the following documents:

 - A File Management Plan (FMP)
 - A Sustainability Outcomes and Implementation Plan which details the targets and method of delivery in respect to Sustainability Outcomes including:
 - On-site power generation;
 - On-site water capture and re-use;
 - Renewable energy;
 - Correct housing orientation for passive heating and cooling;
 - Investigation of the feasibility of the provision of public transport and the integration of the subdivision and future built form with public transport;
 - A Local Water Management Strategy.

- Structure Plan(s) are to include:
 - A requirement for the preparation and endorsement of Design Guidelines prior to subdivision. Design Guidelines are to ensure a range of development which is consistent with the Vision for Burekup;
 - Encouraging pedestrian access through the townsite and connectivity for pedestrians, cyclists, people with disabilities, seniors, etc;
 - Encouraging pedestrian access through the townsite and connectivity for pedestrians, cyclists, people with disabilities, seniors, etc;
 - Provision of affordable housing; and
 - Encouraging the retention of existing mature trees in road reserves, where possible, practical and safe.
 - Requirement for public open space plan addressing water sensitive urban design principles, multifunctional use of areas, used as a land use buffer where appropriate, planting with endemic species, tree management access.
- Subdivision and development of land (subject to commercial purposes on the Strategy Plan) is not to occur until the land is suitably zoned and a Structure Plan endorsed by the Shire and WARC. The Structure Plan shall include car parking design guidelines.


