## Tourist Information Board

- Quote for design of noticeboard has been sought with estimated cost being \$9,075 based upon:
  - Manufacture galvanized heavy duty steel frame and legs, etch primed and painted.
  - Height 1220mm x 3370mm wide plus legs, slashing over the front.
  - Aluminum composite panel front and back with laminated digital print for centre.
  - 2 x lockable exterior cork back notice boards.
